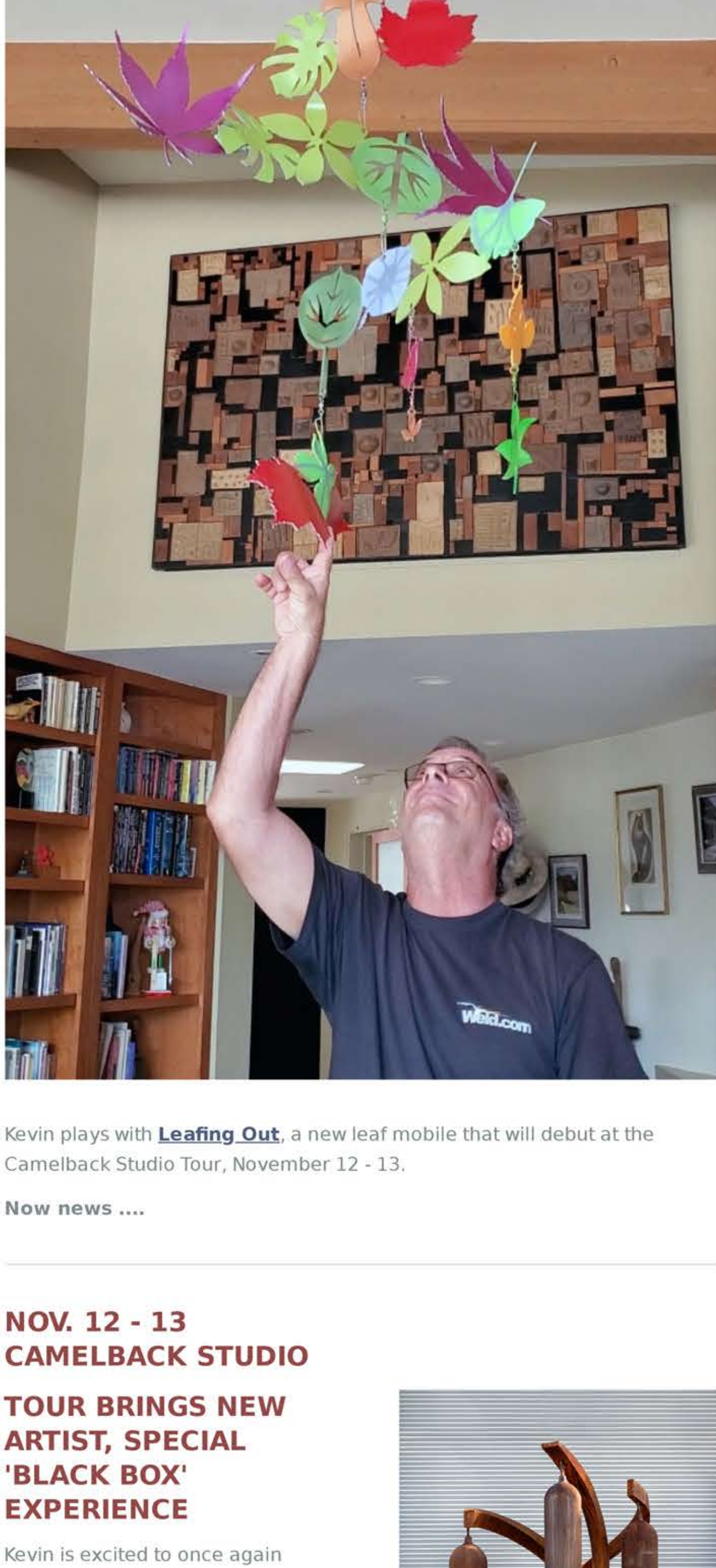

Kevin is excited to once again participate in the **Camelback Studio Tour** and to welcome a new artist to his 3D-printing studio and home.

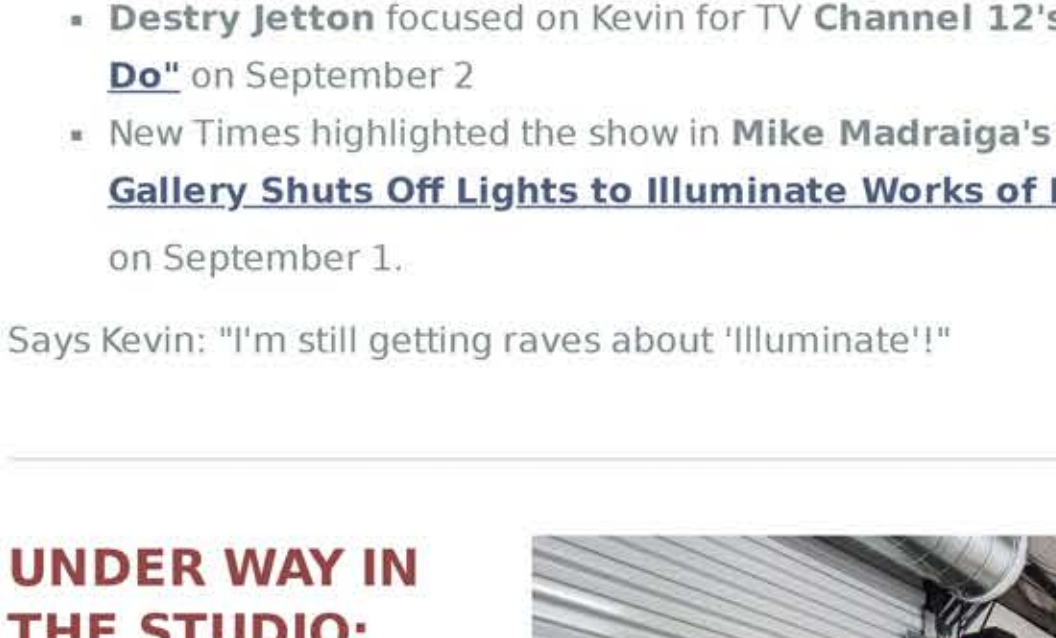

People are also excited about the "black box" experience being introduced this year. "This will really allow my lighted sculptures to shine!" says Kevin. "This is going to be really special!"

If you missed the recent terrific show "Illuminate,"

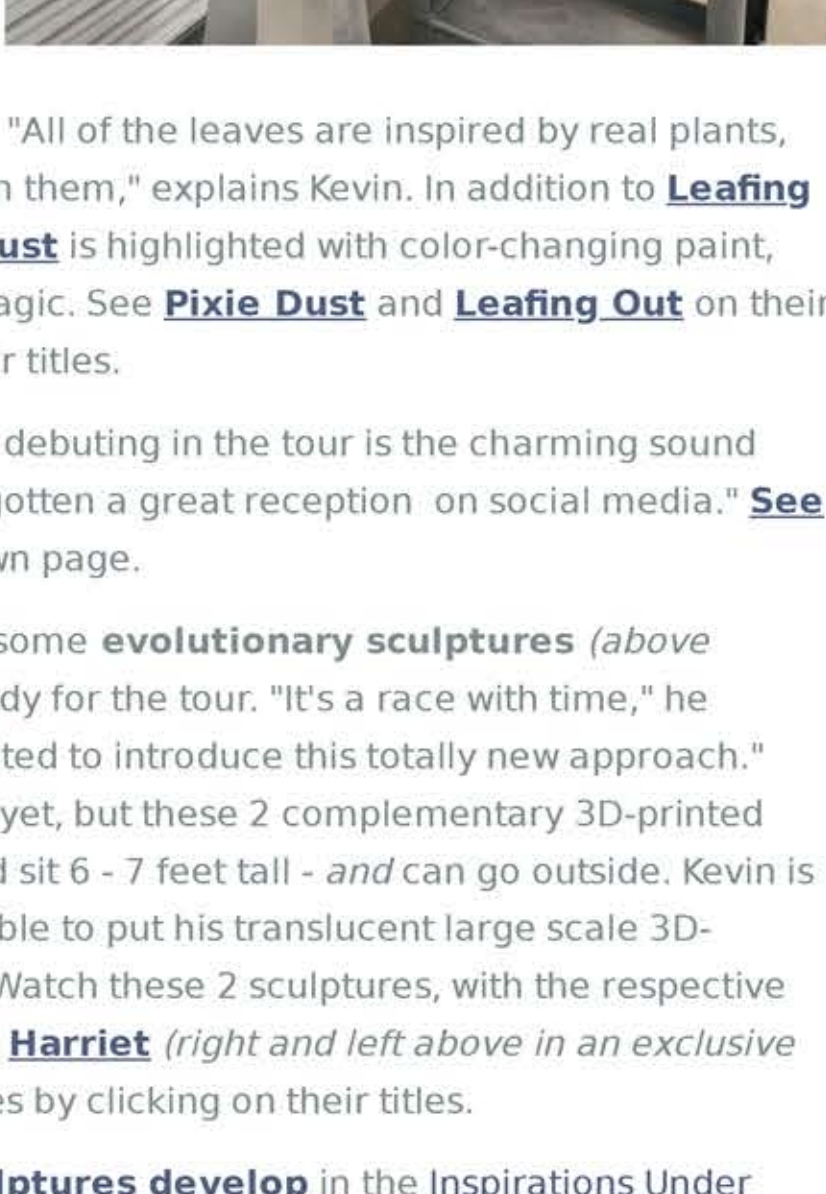
you can enjoy it vicariously - or if you were there you can relive pleasant memories - through some of the additional press coverage it received:

UNDER WAY IN THE STUDIO: READY FOR COMPANY

The upcoming **Camelback Studio Tour** may take place in Kevin's 3D-printing studio, but he's been busy creating work for the event in his metalworking studio, too.



Two new leaf mobiles, with fresh color palettes and leaf types - and a little sparkle - are among the new sculptures available. "All of the leaves are inspired by real plants, but of course, I put my spin on them," explains Kevin. In addition to **Leafing Out**, the leaf mobile **Pixie Dust** is highlighted with color-changing paint, giving it an extra splash of magic. Along with **Hell's Bells**, also debuting in the tour is the charming sound sculpture **CutUp**, which has gotten a great reception on social media. **See - and hear - CutUp** on its own page.

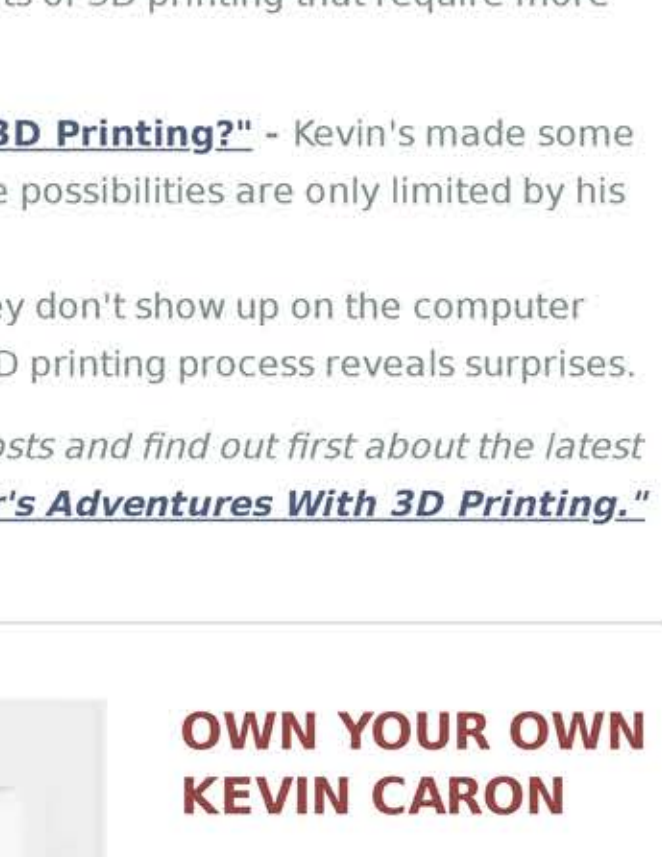
Not to be overshadowed are some **evolutionary sculptures** (above right) Kevin plans to have ready for the tour. "It's a race with time," he admits, "but I'm super motivated to introduce this totally new approach." They don't have formal titles yet, but these 2 complementary 3D-printed sculptures will be painted and sit 6 - 7 feet tall - and can go outside. Kevin is also currently testing being able to put his translucent large scale 3D-printed sculptures outdoors. FUN AND FRUSTRATION

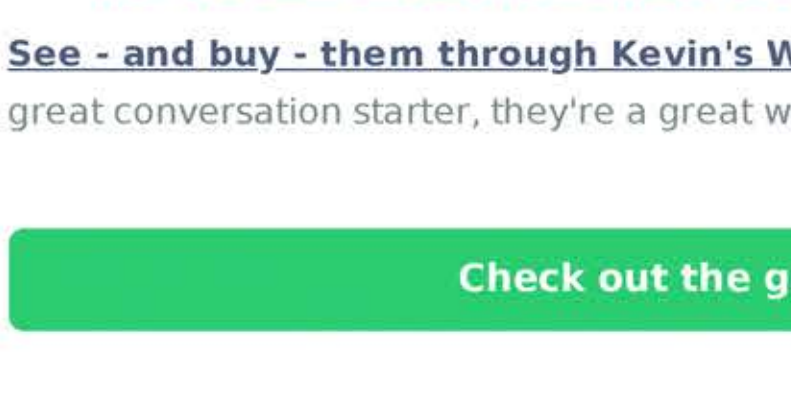

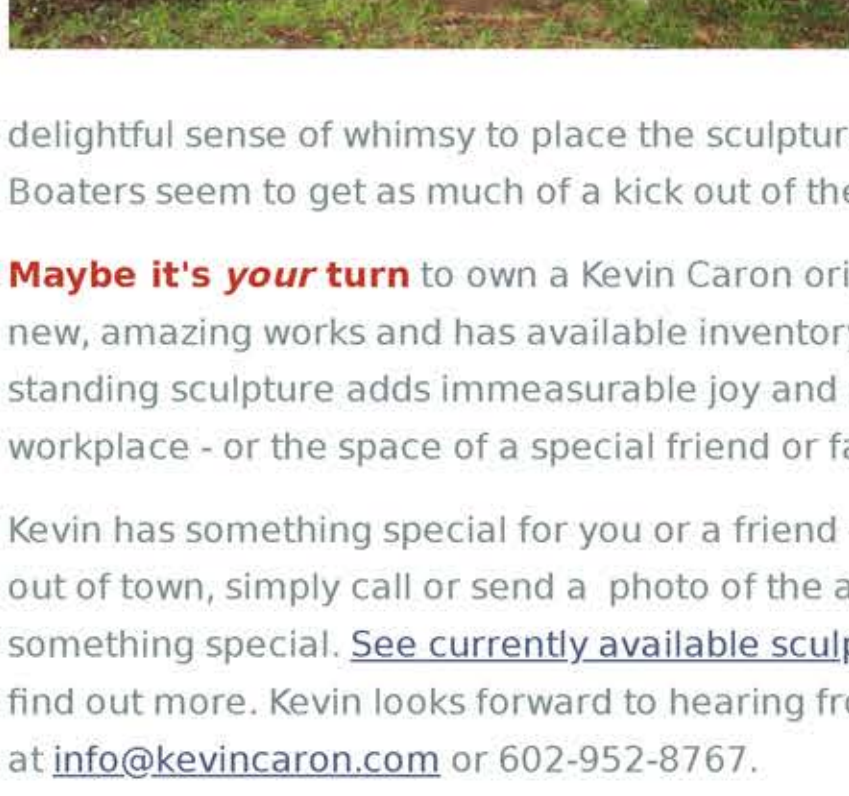
